LEARN

- ✓  Create quarterly video on rights.
- ✓  Increase regional advocacy efforts.
- ✓  Recognize the role trauma may play in a person's life and choices.



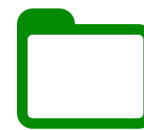
WORK
