Make A House A Home



A Butler County program that helps individuals with disabilities take the expense and hassle out of moving to their first home.

Make A House A Home is a parent driven program to support individuals with disabilities who are moving to the community for the first time. Make A House A Home provides the basic items needed to set up a household at no cost.

Am I Eligible?

Yes, if you currently are eligible for services through Butler County Board of Developmental Disabilities.

Yes, if you are currently moving from your parent's home or a facility to your own home or apartment.

How Do I Receive Services? It's Easy!

Contact your support coordinator with Butler County Board of Developmental Disabilities. If you are not sure who your support coordinator is, call 1-513-785-2800 for help.

Provide the support coordinator with a list of items needed (see checklist of household items provided) and the delivery date and location. They will submit a referral form to Make A House A Home.

Checklist of Household Items Provided

Linens:

- Towels and washcloths
- Shower curtain
- Sheets, bedspread, blanket
- Drapes, curtains, window blinds (when available)
- Kitchen dishcloths/towels

Kitchen area:

- Pots and pans
- Dishes
- Silverware
- Glassware
- Utensils (spatula, spoons, etc.)
- Baking supplies (pans, measuring cups, cookie sheets)

Cleaning Supplies:

- Sponges, pot scratchers
- Dish soap
- Mops, brooms, buckets
- Cleaning chemicals (Windex, furniture polish, toilet cleaner, etc.)
- Paper towels and holder, toilet paper, kleenex

Small appliances:

- Mixer
- Blender
- Toaster
- Can opener
- Coffee pot

Decorative Items/Personal Needs:

- Wall clock
- Pictures
- Coasters
- Alarm clock
- First aid supplies
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, etc.)
- Dry erase board

Other:

- Pantry supply/staples (salt/pepper, oil, sugar, flour, paper plates, napkins)
- Storage bags, trash bags
- Office supplies (paper, pencils, pens, tape, scissors)
- Meal for move in day
