\$28 MILLION BUDGET



75% of the Board's total budget of \$28,144,616 comes from a tax levy. The Board was last on the ballot in 2004.



In the last five years, the Board has brought \$250 million into Butler County from services provided or purchased.



Our services are also funded by a combination of state and federal dollars, allowing people with disabilities to live, work, and lead meaningful lives in Butler County.

458 Youth supported to find work and other services after high school.



1,986 People received Service & Support Administration (SSA) services.



551 Investigations of incidents adversely affecting health & welfare were conducted.



1,457 Families received Family Support Services.



254 Partner agencies & independent providers in our community.



362 People were employed in the community.



50 People with disabilities gave back & volunteered in the community.



454 Adults received services from community providers during the day.



1,102 People received support to live, work and learn in the community.



155 In-home supports provided to families and children.



196 Staff employed full time.
