Ashtabula: 1.3 mill Renewal Levy. PASSED, 62%

Athens: 1.8 mill Replacement Levy. PASSED, 69%

Defiance: 1.9 mill Replacement Levy. PASSED, 64%

Mahoning: 3 mill Renewal Levy. PASSED, 70%

Marion: 3 mill Renewal Levy. PASSED, 59%

Medina: 1.12 mill Replacement Levy. PASSED, 60%

Montgomery: 6.03 mill Replacement Levy.* PASSED, 65%

Portage: 1.8 mill Renewal Levy. PASSED, 65%

Putnam: .5 Replacement Levy. PASSED, 62%

Vinton: 2 mill Renewal Levy. PASSED, 55%

Williams: 2.5 mill Replacement Levy. PASSED, 53%
