**3,600 people with developmental disabilities receive services**



1,300 adults (22 years old and older)



1,100 school-age children (6 to 21 years old)



1,200 infants & young children (birth to 5 years old)



150 full-time Board employees



Our primary source of funding is from property tax levies collected annually. We were last on the ballot in 2004.

## All services for people with developmental disabilities are paid for by local tax dollars, and state and federal funds.

### services for children

We provide in-home support and coaching to families with children under 3 years old.

### support coordination

We arrange for support for people 3 years old and up through their lifetime, if needed. Service plans are developed with individuals and families to design supports provided through partner agencies.

### services for adults

We provide funding to individuals so they can choose provider agencies who support them to engage in their community through day services, recreation and employment. With our funding, provider agencies offer job training and development so people can find work in the community.

### community inclusion

We support people so they can participate in all aspects of community life, advocate, and speak up for themselves.

### quality assurance

We investigate health and safety issues, and we monitor and offer support to provider agencies.
