#### Family Support Services Allowable and Non-Allowable Expenses 2023

Butler County families are allocated up to **\$1500** for each qualifying family member for 2023. This <u>does not</u> mean that Family Support Services (FSS) has these funds set aside for you. Funds may be exhausted within a program year and are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. All requests must meet an assessed need and may require verification of need (VON). <u>Preapproval is required</u> for all items/services requested.

### Allowable Items/Services:

# All items must meet an assessed need related to the individual's disability MUST have Verification of Need (VON)

Adaptive Equipment Special Diet Items	Ex: wheelchairs*, walkers*, lifts*, communication devices*, educational/developmental tools or equipment, compression vests, adaptive shoes, adaptive bikes, glasses*, special diets with a physician order, mini trampoline, colostomy/ostomy care items *If on Medicaid, must provide a denial letter for the item.
Therapy/Counseling Services -Must be accredited/licensed in a non- educational setting or family home. Must have therapeutic need indicated by a therapist. -Must be provided by licensed/certified professionals.	Ex: Equine, Hippo, music, occupational, physical, speech, swim class, karate class
Technology	Ex: computer*, tablet*, headphones, magnifiers, talking devices -If for education, must provide a denial letter from the school. Not to meet an educational need or service - <u>Please note</u> : Computers/Laptops can be purchased for children 3 years and older Technology items can be purchased <u>once every three years</u> *If on Medicaid, must provide a denial letter for the device.

## Items not covered:

- ✓ Items of General Utility, (ex.: pool slides, swing sets, trampolines, fences)
- ✓ Memberships/subscriptions (ex: gyms, fitness, organizations)
- ✓ Transportation/travel cost (ex: mileage, motels, meals, bus, cab, uber, Lyft, taxi)
- Household bills to include but not limited to the following: rent, mortgage, utilities, car, air conditioners, home additions, maintenance/repair, expansion of square footage, taxes, legal fees/fines, food
- Medical services include but are not limited to the following: Vision, dental, diaper, physician, and hospital services. Oxygen, psychological, testing, rehabilitative, day treatment program, medical/mental health, hearing, hospital laboratory, long-term care, dialysis, durable medical equipment used for medical purposes
- Medical bills/supplies: copays not related to therapy, treatment, prescription/nonprescription medications, OTC vitamins
- ✓ Tuition at private schools
- ✓ Furniture/household goods including home safety items: (ex: baby gates, strollers, highchairs, car seats)
- Any services/items covered by another funding source (County vouchers, Medicaid (waivers included) Medicare, Bureau for Children for Medical handicaps, or other medical plans)
